#### PARANYM

A word or phrase with the same meaning as another, but with a more positive or polite inference.

dearly departed sleep with

#### PARONYMS

Words with the same stem or root, but different meaning.

affect promise paranym effect premise paronym

dead

# HYPERNYM

A broad term for a group of elements or category.

flower colour

food fish

#### **HYPONYM**

A specific element that can also be named by the category in which it sits.

rose rose

fish plaice

NOTE: A word can be both a hypernym and hyponym.



# ANTONYMS

Different words meaning the opposite of each other.

hot cold fast slow

# AUTANTONYM

A word with two opposite meanings.

dust add or remove small

particles

literally specifically or figuratively



Is it important to know the -nyms?

Will they help you communicate?

It's unlikely.

Should they be left to die in Greece?

Probably.
